

# Cash bonus for Nursery

NORTH Kensington's Maxilla Nursery Centre has scooped a £35,000 cash windfall.

The nursery in Maxilla Walk, has received the money as part of the Department of the Environment's Urban Aid programme.

Some £28,000 will go towards expanding the centre's baby-care facilities from eight to 12 children, while the remaining £7,000 will go towards running costs of the nursery and pre-school playgroup amenities which cater for over 70 children.

Says co-ordinator Judy Wilcox: "This is tremendous news for us — we were hoping that we could expand out space for children under 18 months because we are terribly short of room at the moment.

Says hoping that we can go ahead with the building extensions as soon as possible so that they can be in use by autumn with any luck".

The aid programme is also making a grant of £6,500 towards the Kensal Toy Library and Under Fives Project which is based at Toynee Hall in Commercial Street, North Kensington.
